DIRECTIONS TO THE SS ORIOLE

Board the SS Oriole behind the Queen's Quay terminal building, 207 Queens Quay West (at York St. and Queens Quay West). Refer to specific directions on second page.

Look for Tina Rogers and Fiona Fisher, who will be there to welcome you aboard.

If you miss the boat, do not despair. You can catch a water taxi (at your own expense); just call 416-203-TAXI (8294).

> VIA GPS: enter 207 Queens Quay West as the destination

The schedule

- 10:30 a.m. (sharp) Board the SS Oriole (see directions below)
- 11:00 a.m. Arrive at Hanlan's Point for welcomes, nibbles, and mingling
- 11:45 a.m. Enjoy introductions, grace, and blessing
- 12:00 p.m. Indulge in a gourmet lunch with your skipper and mate
- 2:15 p.m. Board your skipper's private yacht
- 2:30 p.m. Begin your sailing adventure
- 5:00 p.m. Disembark near Pier 4 at York St.

Other details

- Attire: Set Sail for Hope happens rain or shine. Dress is smart casual. No jeans or cut-off shorts, please. We also request that you wear shoes with non-marking soles. Hats and windbreakers are always good accessories to have on hand.
- Participants must be 19 years of age or older. No pets allowed.
- Please ensure your whole party arrives; we don't want to disappoint our chefs.
- Unexpected additional guests cannot be accommodated.
- We promise there are no additional costs at the event and no requests will be made for donations.

MAP AND DIRECTIONS



BY CAR: From West

Take Highway 401 East to Highway 427 South to Gardiner Expressway Toronto. Take the Spadina exit to Lakeshore West ramp (eastbound). Continue on Lakeshore West and turn right onto Lower Simcoe Street.

From North

Take Highway 400 South to Highway 401 West to Highway 427 South, then Highway 427 South to Gardiner Expressway Toronto. Take the Spadina exit to Lakeshore West (eastbound). Turn right onto Lower Simcoe Street.

VIA GPS: enter 207 Queens Quay West as the destination

BY TTC:

From Union Station, board either the 509 Harbourfront or 510 Spadina streetcar (underground) and get off at York Street.

PARKING:

Harbourfront parking garage is located on the west side of Queen's Quay Terminal (207 Queens Quay West).

You can access the lot by coming south on Lower Simcoe and driving straight into the garage or from the westbound Queens Quay W from Yonge and Bay Streets.

Note that Eastbound Queens Quay traffic is not permitted to turn right onto Lower Simcoe.

From East

Take Highway 401 West to Don Valley Parkway South. Take Don Valley Parkway South to Gardiner Expressway. Once on Gardiner Expressway, take the Lakeshore Blvd. West exit. Once on Lakeshore, turn left onto Yonge Street and then right onto Queens Quay. Proceed straight ahead to Lower Simcoe Street.
